


The Historic Artcraft Theatre was built in 1922 and served as the social hub and emotional heart of downtown Franklin until closing as a full-time theatre in 2000. Franklin Heritage, Inc. purchased the Artcraft in 2004 and is proud to present this year's third annual Spirits on Stage haunted tour.

Prior to the introduction of television, theatres were an integral part of any community. Theatre newsreels provided some of the only national news. The back rows of dark auditoriums were the prime dating venues, and movies showing glamour and happier times provided hope during the Depression and war years.

It is not surprising that theatres, including the Artcraft, were so dearly loved. Some theatres seem to be loved so much that even death has not separated the bond, and the Artcraft is no exception. The spirits on stage — ghosts who even in the afterlife seek the attention of an audience.





Downtown Franklin will be awakened by the


rumble of hearses at the Spirits on Stage "Wakin' the Dead" Hearse Show in front of the Historic Artcraft Theatre.
